Dear Parents and Carers,

Music ensembles / tuition at RGS

We would like to warmly welcome your children to the Music Department! We are really looking forward to meeting them all, and encouraging an enjoyment in Music irrespective of their levels of musical experience. Here are a few opportunities to make you aware of what your child can get involved in.

Extra-Curricular Ensembles

We have a bustling and vibrant array of extra-curricular music ensembles, which we highly encourage everyone to try. Please see a brief description of what we have to offer for Year 7s:

- **Junior Choir:** open to everyone, a large choir in which we sing a range of songs of different musical styles, and perform in 3 concerts, the Carol Service and Evensong music trips. The rehearsals for this are split into Year 7 Trebles (for higher voices), Year 8/9 Trebles (for higher voices), and Altos (for Year 7, 8, 9 lower voices).
- **2nd Wind Band:** for woodwind, brass and percussion instruments Grade 0-4
- **1st Wind Band:** for woodwind, brass and percussion instruments Grade 4+
- **Swing Band:** for woodwind, brass and percussion instruments Grade 4+
- **Junior Strings:** a string ensemble for players Grade 0-4
- **Senior Strings:** a string ensemble for players Grade 4+
- **Guitar Ensemble:** a group for Classical guitarists run by the Classical Guitar peripatetic tutor. Please email us to sign you up directly with him.
- **Brass Group:** for brass instruments Grade 4+
- **Mini Close Harmony:** an auditioned ensemble of a small group of singers Years 7-9, with a focus on close harmony/barbershop style singing

Instrumental Tuition

You can sign up your child for instrumental lessons during school time with our team of 20 peripatetic tutors, all experienced professional musicians who offer a wide range of instruments to learn. Learning a musical instrument is a brilliant opportunity to develop your child, supporting and enhancing so many transferable skills that have a positive impact on both their academic and social experience in school. It enables them to join more of our extra-curricular ensembles, becoming part of the RGS Music community, and could be the start of a wonderful lifelong musical journey.
