### **Heart Monitoring for Young People**

I am looking into asking a Company called CRY (Cardiac Risk in the Young) to come into School to perform cardiac monitoring for students in Year 9 and above. The purpose of the screening is to detect undiagnosed heart conditions that could potentially lead to sudden death in young people.

Each person would have an Electrocardiogram (ECG) and complete a medical questionnaire, which will be reviewed by a CRY doctor. If required they would also have an Echocardiogram.

I estimate that the total cost will be between £65 - £85 per person. If you are interested in this service please press on the link to complete the form. The deadline for your response is **Monday 29 April**. Payment will be required at a later date when and if a visit can be confirmed.

If there is enough interest I will arrange for CRY to attend School as soon as possible. They can screen 100 people per day and we would accept applications on a first come first served basis.
