Alternatively you are able to purchase a digital subscription for <u>all</u> four textbooks through the school, and the cost for the year for <u>all four textbooks together</u> is £32.50. Parents can purchase this by ParentPay up until Friday 13th September 2024 (a/c "Year 13 FURTHER MATHS A-level digital textbook subscription for 2024/2025"). PLEASE NOTE: Further Maths students will also be given access to <u>ALL</u> 4 Maths A-level textbooks as well as the Further Maths Core Pure 1 textbook as part of this subscription, so that they can refer to them throughout the year, and also use them for revision.
