Dear Parents / Carers,

The school is looking for someone to act as our Duke of Edinburgh Award Verifier.

This person will be responsible for reviewing whether our students have met the requirements for their DoE Award.

Specifically this will involve:

- Completing an online training session to familiarise yourself with the eDoE website and review process.
- Around 30 minutes of activity per week. This will primarily involve logging in to the eDoE website and approving the evidence the school and student has provided for the various components of their award.

The role is completely flexible and can be done at any time suitable to you. However, it is a vitally important role for our DoE programme and can only be performed by someone who is independent of the programme.

At RGS we have a long tradition of students achieving DoE Awards with around 270 students involved each year and on average 35 students achieving the prestigious Gold DoE Award which is presented to them at Buckingham Palace by a member of the Royal Family.

We would be hugely grateful to any parent, carer or friend of the school who would be able to support us and our students to continue this great tradition.
