THE ANNUAL FRORGS AWARDS - WEDNESDAY 26 MARCH 2025, 7-9PM

The categories for the awards are:

The awards are restricted to Years 7-9 in order to give as much encouragement as possible to the players in the lower years. The teams represented will be U12 Allan, Dawson, Harris and Wade, U13ABC and U14ABC.

Each team will have three awards. There will be no distinction between teams as the awards are intended to recognise players of all levels of experience. The awards are metal badges specially designed for this event, which the winners can wear on their blazers.

The event will be held in The Queen's Hall on Wednesday 26 March 2025 from 7-9pm, with current Captains of the RGS 1st XV, Adam Boodhun and James Kucera presenting the awards.

Players and parents assemble in The Queen's Hall at 7pm to enjoy a meal at 7:30pm, followed by the Award presentations. Individual tickets cost £15 or £50 for a family of 4 and will be available to purchase via [Little Box Office](#) until Wednesday 19 March. Dress code is casual, no school uniform required.
